Regular Meeting
May 8th, 2018

President Schaible called the meeting to order @ 7:31 p.m. Roll was answered by R. Nolan, D. Brotherton, L. Zigler, D. Teberg, E. Murphy, B. Gable.

E. Murphy motioned to accept the minutes from the April 10th regular meeting. B. Gable seconded. Motion carried 6-0. B. Gable motioned to accept the minutes from April 30th special meeting. L. Zigler seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

B. Nolan motioned to accept the bills. D. Brotherton seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

D. Teberg motioned to accept the treasurers report. B. Gable seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Present in the audience was S. Johnson, S. Kloss, L. Kloss, H. Brotherton, E. Walters, S. Hamilton, S. Buck, all representing Girls Scouts Troop 5270.
