An Ordinance appropriating for all corporate purposes of the Village of Hanover, Jo Daviess County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 01, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED by the PRESIDENT and the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE OF HANOVER, JO DAVIESS COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The following sums, or so much thereof as hereby may be authorized by law, and as may be needed or deemed necessary to pay all necessary expenses and liabilities of the municipality and the same as hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes of the Village of Hanover, Jo Daviess County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 01, 2018, and ending April 30, 2019.

SECTION 2: That the appropriations herein made for any purpose shall be regarded as the maximum amounts to be expended under the respective appropriation accounts and shall not be construed as a commitment, agreement, obligation or liability of the Village of Hanover, Jo Daviess County, Illinois, and such appropriations being subject to further approval as to expenditures thereof by the Village Board.

SECTION 5: By a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the President and Board of Trustees, this Appropriation Ordinance may be revised by deleting, adding to, changing or creating new objects or purposes for which appropriations have or may be made. No revision of this Appropriation Ordinance shall be made adding to the total amount appropriated unless additional funds have been made available during the fiscal year in the amount the total appropriations are so increased

<u>SECTION 6:</u> This Appropriation Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the procedure set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code provided any limitations in conflict with this Ordinance shall not be applicable to this Ordinance pursuant to Section 6 of the Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 7: A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk within thirty (30) days after adoption. The Clerk of the Village of Hanover is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of said County a duly certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
