## VILLAGE OF HANOVER UTILITY VEHICLE ORDINANCE REGULATIONS

(Partial Ordinance)

BEGINNING August 1, 2020 the following regulations must be met to be allowed to operate a
Golf Cart/Utility Vehicle within the
Village of Hanover

All persons age eighteen (18) or older, wanting to operate a utility vehicle/golf cart on Hanover Village streets, during daylight hours, MUST comply with the following requirements:

- 1.) Provide proof of current liability insurance.
- 2.) Register & have inspected by the Police Chief or his designated officer.
- 3.) Display Village issued decal/sticker on rear of vehicle.
- 4.) Possess a current valid driver's license.
- 5.) Have vehicle equipped with the following:
  - a. Horn
  - b. Brakes and brake lights
  - c. Turn signals
  - d. Steering wheel apparatus
  - e. Tires
  - f. Rearview mirror
  - g. Approved "Slow moving vehicle" emblem on rear of vehicle.
  - h. Red reflector warning devises on both front and rear of vehicle,
  - Headlights with white lights visible from a distance of 500 feet to the front while in operation.
  - j. Tail lights that emit read light visible from a distance of 100 feet from the rear of the vehicle while in operation.
  - k. Seatbelts for operator and all passengers when vehicle is in operation, with a maximum occupancy of vehicle equal to the amount of seatbelts in vehicle.
- 6.) Obey all traffic laws of State of Illinois & Village of Hanover; shall not operate utility vehicle/golf cart on any State highway, and may cross Highway 84/Jefferson St./Washington St. SAFELY at any intersection in Village limits.
- 7.) Vehicle must yield the Right of Way to overtaking vehicles at all times.
- 8.) Obey the posted Speed Limit OR 25 MPH, whichever is less.
- 9.) A person operating the utility vehicle/golf cart on a street while under the influence of drugs/alcohol is subject to Sections 11-500 thru 11-502 of Illinois Vehicle Code.

PERMITS/INSPECTIONS need to be done thru Hanover Police Department. Cost is \$25 annually. Need to provide name, address, phone number, proof of insurance, serial #, make, model & description of vehicle.

VIOLATIONS: A violation of any of this Ordinance shall be punishable of a fine of not less than \$75 and not more than \$500 & any other enforcement costs incurred by the Village, which could include revocation of at least 1 year, up to 3 years.
