

Hanover Village Board
July 14th, 2020
Regular Meeting

President Schaible called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by L. Speer, D. Brotherton, L. Zigler, D. Grube, E. Murphy, B. Gable.

E. Murphy motioned to approve last month's regular meeting minutes. L. Zigler seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

After review of the Bills D. Brotherton motioned to pay the monthly Bills. B. Gable seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

B. Gable motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. L. Zigler seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Audience present was D. Griffin, M. Penistein, P. Penistein, J Ohms asking about website updates on emergency centers and when the new siren would be hooked up. President Schaible has been in contact with contractors to come hook up sirens. The board will follow up on website updates. C. Reitz wondered about the swamp property next to her property and inquired about adding names to the Veterans Memorial. President Schaible said the property is privately owned and is for sale. The Veterans Memorial used to be funded by fundraisers that no longer exist. If someone wants to add names they have to pay for them to be added and can get in touch with Kay at the Village Office. N. Speer was discussing cats in the Manor.

Township Hall Warranty Deed for Warranty Deed to swap properties has been acquired and will be moving forward with the swap.

Property Demolition Boop property has been finished. 128 Wapello is still being looked into for back taxes owed. Middendorf's trailer is signed over to Village but still needs to be recorded at the courthouse. There is a person of interest in the property and will pay the back taxes, take out the trailer and fix up the garage. This would save the village approx. \$5,500. B. Gable motioned to have the attorney draw up a quick claim deed to be put on the agenda for next month. E. Murphy seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Zoning Admin S. Murphy gave the Zoning Report as follows 503 Jefferson was approved for a premade shed to be added to the property. R. Douvakis was approved for permit of concrete slab for pavilion.

Task Force reports various properties still need cleaned up and will be passing the info on to Zoning Admin and or Chief Wand.

Cameras are scheduled to be installed by Aarrow in the park and around the village. Down payment of half has been issued and they are scheduled to start installation the week of July 20th.

Elizabeth Tire A letter was sent to the EPA. EPA has been in contact with the Mayor and will be doing an inspection. After completion of inspection the EPA will write a letter to the Village of the inspection.

Street Project is coming along pretty well with only a couple issues that are being worked out.

Motor Fuel- Streets Motor Fuel monies can be used to do seal coating of streets. \$146,000 in the budget right now but will be put on hold till next year as to hopefully tie into the state project of redoing highway 84 from the bridge to Authur St.

Appropriation Ordinance B. Gable motioned to pass the 2020-2021 Appropriation Ordinance with the same numbers as last year. L.Zigler seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Ordinances- General Discussion was held on Village Ordinance governing utility vehicles and will review and rewrite with Chief Wand. The Ordinance on chickens and roosters will be looked into by Zoning Admin.

Committee Reports No department head meeting was held due to unavailability by personnel.

D. Brotherton had to leave at 8:44 due to medical call and fire department assistance. Adjournment was made at 8:53 p.m. by L. Zigler. B. Gable seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
