

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Village of Hanover will hold a public hearing on September 28, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., in the Village of Hanover's Village Hall to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Ms. Kay Temperly at Village Hall, 207 Jefferson Street, Hanover, IL 61041, or by phone at 815-581-3800, to meet these needs no later than end of business on Friday, September 25, 2020. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about September 30, 2020, the Village of Hanover intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: sanitary sewer system rehabilitation and improvements, including Cured-In-Place (CIP) lining, strategic point repairs, and lining and/or replacement of sanitary manholes. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$500,000. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons \$278,650, which is 55.73%.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of September 21, 2020, one week prior to the public hearing. Documents will be on-hand for review at Village Hall, located at 207 Jefferson Street, Hanover, IL 61041 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Interested residents are invited to provide comments regarding project either at the public hearing or by written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Ms. Kay Temperly, 207 Jefferson Street, Hanover, IL 61041 no later than end of business on September 28, 2020 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the Village of Hanover and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
