

Village of Hanover
Special Meeting/ Public Hearing
February 23rd, 2023

The Public Hearing led by Bridget Stocks/ Fehr Graham and President Schaible was held at 5:00 p.m. Roll was answered by L. Speer, D. Brotherton, K. Gable, L. Zigler, E. Murphy, M. Holland. Also in attendance was Attorney T. Kurt and Village Clerk N. Ritchie. B. Stocks explained the EPA loan for the lead service line replacement project. There will be a 10 day public comment period; after that the official plan approval will move forward. Public Hearing closed at 5:20 p.m.

The Village board special meeting continued with a grant update from B. Stocks regarding comminutor and lining. No public hearing required for this grant.

Street Project and Motor Fuel Tax: Installation and cost for replacement of eight handicap ramps in the street project was discussed. The state assessment for possible funding from the state to pay for the ramps could take up to a year and keep the project from moving forward. Estimated cost per the engineers is \$53,862.84. The Village can pay for the ramps out of the budget for the street project to be able to move forward. K. Gable motioned to move forward with the project planning and to take bids and pay for the handicap ramps without involving the state. M. Holland seconded. Motion carried 6-0.

Water Connection - Franklin St. - Discussion: A survey is required to start the digging. President Schaible will sign for the survey to move forward.

Auditors have filed an extension for the Village Audit.

Full Time Hire Job Description was presented to the board and discussed. The Village will be accepting applications for an entry level position for the Water, Sewer and Public works department.

Vehicle stickers, parking and zoning violations discussed.
