Regular Meeting Minutes

November 11th 2025

Mayor N. Flack called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler. Also in attendance in attendance were Police Chief T. Wand, Village Clerk N. Ritchie, Attorney T. Kurt, and Zoning Admin C. Henkins. J. Parisi was absent.

- D. Schaible motioned to accept the Treasurers Report. D. Brotherton seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

2025 Motor Fuel Project – Payments have been completed.

Fiber Report – Mayor Flack will meet with JCE CO-OP on Thursday and will update the board if there are new updates.

Animal Control Contract – E. Murphy motioned to extend the Animal Control Contract from December $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ - November $\mathbf{30}^{\text{th}}$ 2026. J. Marcotte seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Committee Reports – Lead line testing is almost complete 1 left to test. Cross connection (backflow preventers) will be scheduled for inspection next month or water will be shut off if not tested per mandatory compliance.

Lagoon – Both ponds have built up sediment that have formed islands and will need to be cleaned out for proper operation. Fehr Graham is looking into grants to help fund this expensive project. Proposed project date is 2027.

Zoning Update – 1 garage permit was issued.

8390 Rt 84 S. – Discussion of inspection to be scheduled.

Police Report – Discussion was held on complaints of speeding on Village side streets. Police Chief reported that radar is being run and patrolled heavy on streets but not many tickets are issued due to the fact vehicles are not breaking the speed limit. Discussion was had on Lexipol program and sharing cost with Elizabeth. Lexipol agency keeps police officers up to date on policies. L. Zigler motioned to share Lexipol program cost with Elizabeth and invoice Elizabeth for reimbursement for half of payments already made by the Village of Hanover for fees paid last year and this year. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

2121 W. Hanover Rd. – Architect is working on plans to move forward with the project. They will need to get with the County on entrance and exit variations.

Park District – Valerie Slayton – Spoke to the board about the park districts plans to apply for a grant from T-Mobile to update the old baseball diamond at the park district an asked for the Villages support of the project.

Board Comments – Discussion on factory interests and new hire was had. No action was taken.
