January 13th, 2026

Regular Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by J. Parisi, D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler. Also in attendance was Attorney T. Kurt, Police Chief T. Wand, Zoning Admin C. Henkins and Village Clerk N. Ritchie.

E. Murphy motioned to pass the minutes from the December 9th, 2026 meeting. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

D. Schaible motioned to pay the monthly bills. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

L. Zigler motioned to accept the Treasurer's report. J. Marcotte seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Discussion was had on EMT Class fees for residents of the village. C. Henkins said he would contact the Elizabeth EMT for details. Consensus was to pay for the class fees with yrs of service commitment agreement if Elizabeth EMT's don't already pay for classes.

Garbage Fees: Montgomery Disposal has raised pickup rates for garbage services. This will increase individuals garbage rate less than 1\$ per month.

2025 Budget Performance – Purchase Lawn mower – Budget was in good standing and will allow for a purchase of a new lawn mower that the village is in need of this spring.

2026 Budget Discussion – Discussion was had on the 2026 budget. Audit change of legal requirements will allow for more money in the budget as it is now required every 4 yrs as opposed to every year.

Tree Trimming in the area of power lines where lines are running through trees need trimmed before a storm could cause damage and result in power

outages. D. Schaible motioned to approve the \$10,000.00 tree trimming budget for hire. E. Murphy seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Fiber Report – There was an error on the fiber construction map. The map is corrected to show Hanover's construction phase progress.

Committee Reports – Backflow preventer testing is up to date. Backhoe thumb was discussed.

White Park Restrooms – Discussion of residing, adding outlets, drinking fountain and overall improvements. No action was taken.

Lagoon Buildup – Discussion of design plans and engineering plus grant fees for application.

Zoning Report – 1 permit was issued.

8390 Rt 84 S. – Tickets are issued and paid monthly for ordinance violations.

Police Report – Elm St. cleanup was discussed and will follow up on the cleanup progress.
