Regular Meeting Minutes

April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026

President N. Flack called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by J. Parisi, D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler.

E. Murphy motioned to approve the March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting minutes. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

D. Brotherton motioned to pay the monthly bills. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

D. Brotherton motioned to accept the Treasurers Report. J. Marcotte seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

May Motorcycle Awareness Month Ordinance- D. Schaible motioned to approve the recognition of 39 years of A.B.A.T.E of Illinois for Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Month in the State of Illinois. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Lagoon Buildup – Mayor Flack reported to the board the condition of lagoon and repairs needed. Also Fehr Graham will be doing testing on lagoon depth.
