Regular Meeting

Village Board President N. Flack called the meeting to order at 7p.m.

Roll was answered by J. Parisi, D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler. Also in attendance were Village Attorney T. Kurt, Zoning Admin C. Henkins, and Police Chief T. Wand.

Motion to approve the April 14th meeting minutes was made by D. Schaible and seconded by L. Zigler. Motion passed 6-0.

Motion to pay the monthly bills was made by D. Brotherton and seconded by J. Marcotte. Motion passed 6-0.

Motion to approve the Treasurer's report was made by D. Brotherton and seconded by E. Murphy. Motion passed 6-0.

Discussion was held regarding the curb repair on Garfield St. and near the VFW on Fillmore St. Motion was made by J. Parisi to approve up to \$15,000.00 in repairs. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Discussion was held on water and monitoring system. No action was taken.

Village President N. Flack discussed the special use permit process and public hearing process for a request from the property owners of 2121 W Hanover Rd. President N. Flack set the date of June 9th, 2026 for both the Zoning Board Meeting and the Public Hearing to discuss the requests. Zoning Board Meeting will be at 5 p.m. Public Hearing at 6 p.m. and Village Board Meeting at 7 p.m. all to be held at the Hanover Park District.

Grant opportunities for public housing rehab, and public infrastructure were discussed with no action taken.

Budget discussion was held. D. Schaible motioned to approve the 2026 budget and to also include a \$3 increase per month on sewer and a \$3 increase per month on water. J. Parisi seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Discussion was also held on the well building repairs. Work will begin soon. No action needed.

Cleanup day is May 28th.

Discussion was held regarding the property at 46-52 Blackhawk and 15-35 Osage. The Jo Daviess County Health department will be contacting the State of Illinois plumbing department.
