Regular Meeting

Mayor N. Flack called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by J. Parisi, D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler.

D. Schaible motioned to pass the June 9th, 2026 Public Hearing and Regular meeting minutes. E. Murphy seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

L. Zigler motioned to pay the monthly bills. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 6-0. E. Murphy motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Enterprise Zone Expansion: D. Schaible motioned to pass a Resolution to Authorize an Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement for the Operation of an Enterprise Zone Resolution NO. R-2026-0714 A and an Ordinance Amending The Boundaries of the Joint Northwest Illinois Certified Enterprise Zone Ordinance NO. 2026-0714 B. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Enterprise Zone Lena Expansion: E. Murphy motioned to pass a Resolution to Authorize an Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement for the Operation of an Enterprise Zone Resolution NO. R-2026-0714 C and an Ordinance Amending The Boundaries of The Joint Northwest Illinois Certified Enterprise Zone Ordinance NO. 2026-0714 D. J. Marcotte seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Personnel Committee met with J. Mensendike about sanitary sewer lines are reports show significant water being pumped that is not being pumped out of the wells. Mayor Flack wants to use harmless smoke to detect extra water going into sewer system from unapproved connections. Also discussed was a request from a resident to the board to consider helping pay for repair costs to their property due to sewer line repairs. The board's consensus was to deny funding per the Village Ordinance and lack of funds.

SCADA upgrade of \$150,000 to Water/Sewer remote monitoring and control system was discussed with possible grant funding.

Montgomery Garbage Disposal Cost Increase: D. Brotherton motioned to raise garbage rate to \$20 per month effective immediately. J. Marcotte seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Lagoon – No updates from Fehr Graham

Zoning Admin reports of three permits submitted and approved.

Police Report- Police Chief T. Wand reported of letters and fines being sent in regards to property not being maintained per ordinances. DACRA was discussed also.

105-107 Jefferson St.- Refinancing fell thru.

2121 W. Hanover Rd. no new updates.

EV Charging Station- a 40% grant funding is available and discussion of where to install and if feasible.

Mayor Flack has contacting chain stores/ box stores to see if any of them had interested in developing in Hanover. No response yet.
