Regular Meeting

August 11th 2026

Mayor N. Flack called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll was answered by J. Parisi, D. Brotherton, J. Marcotte, D. Schaible, E. Murphy, L. Zigler.

E. Murphy motioned to approve the July 14th meeting minutes. D. Schaible seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

J. Marcotte motioned to pay the monthly bills. L. Zigler seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

L. Zigler motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. D. Brotherton seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

Committee Reports/ Comments: Committee met with James Mendsendike and discussed water in and water out of sewer system to the lagoon and report was good this month. Hydrants to be replaced were discussed. Hanover Village website rebuild with updated content was discussed.
